

Information on possibilities of participation in the postdocs support program at the Institute of Philosophy of the CAS

The Institute of Philosophy of the Czech Academy of Sciences regularly applies for the support of young researchers within the **Programme of Promotion of Prospective Human Resources – Wage Support for Postdocs at the CAS institutes**. The competition is open to all institutes of the Academy of Sciences and takes place twice a year – in spring and autumn. The programme is intended for holders of a Ph.D. degree or equivalent within two years from receiving it (the time spent on parental/maternity leave is not counted and in case of a long-term postdoc stay in other than the candidate's country of residence is extended to four years). Successful applicants work for two years on a project whose topic is directly related to the focus of the relevant institute of the CAS and become members of one of its scientific teams.

Candidates for this support awarded by the Academy of Sciences of the Czech Republic can contact the head of one of the [scientific departments of the Institute of Philosophy](#) on an ongoing basis (proposals for the internal competition of the Institute are submitted by the head of the department). The current deadline for the submission of project proposals in the 22nd round of the competition is set in the Institute of Philosophy for **30 August 2023**.
