Josef Pallas: Practicing uncertainty as resilience

Based on the pandemic experiences of Swedish welfare professionals and inspired by the work of Hannah Arendt, Simone Weil, Jonna Bornemark, and Isabelle Stengers, the lecture of Josef Pallas, Professor at Department of Business Studies of the Uppsala University advocates for approaching resilience as a transformative rather than a restorative or protective process. In this context, we understand resilience as based on professional judgment that is not only ingrained in the bodies of the professionals, and accumulated over years of socialization within their professional communities and domains. Such judgment also includes the ability and capacity to be attentive to relational knowledge that comes from daily interactions with the world we share with others and to which we have a moral and ethical commitment.
