Husserl's logical grammar

It is well known that Husserl in his Fourth *Logical Investigation* (1901) presents an idea of pure logical grammar. The presentation is brief and sketchy, but substantial enough for later readers to see commonalities with, for instance, Chomsky's idea of a universal grammar. It is less known that Husserl in his lectures on logic during the period 1907-1917 develops his idea of logical grammar in significant detail. In this talk, which draws upon material from a recently published paper, I wish to give an outline of Husserl's logical grammar based on all the sources now available, including his lecture notes.
