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Medieval Note-taking and Notebooks: Results of the ERC NOTA Project and Further Research Questions

The *NOTA (Note-Taking and Notebooks as Channels of Medieval Academic Dissemination across Europe)* project was selected for funding in the 2020 ERC Starting Grant competition. It proposed to study several notebooks pertaining to 14th- and 15th-century scholars from Europe and analyse their sources, note-taking practices, and academic backgrounds. The hypothesis was that such a study would reveal an unexplored dimension of life within medieval universities. In this presentation, I will highlight key results of the project and formulate the new research questions that have emerged from these findings.

This event is a part of a project that has received funding from the European Research Council (ERC) under the Horizon 2020 research and innovation programme (Grant agreement No. 949710). The project *ACADEMIA: Reconstructing Late Medieval Quests for Knowledge: Quodlibetal Debates as Precursors of Modern Academic Practice* is carried out at the Institute of Philosophy of the Czech Academy of Sciences.
