



## INFORMATION ON DOCTORAL STUDIES IN PHILOSOPHY OF EDUCATION

Doctoral programme in *Philosophy of Education* focuses on theories of education in the context of the history of philosophy and, especially, current philosophical conceptions. Philosophy of education is based on critical thought, philosophical anthropology, social and political philosophy, eco-education, and critical pedagogy. These foundations are supplemented by approaches from other social sciences, such as sociocultural and linguistic anthropology, and sociology, with the aim to study general problems in current society. Dissertation theses should deal either with subjects from the philosophy of education or topics of critical thought and other areas of philosophy.

### USE THE OPPORTUNITY

- to do part of your studies at your alma mater and part at the Institute of Philosophy of the Czech Academy of Sciences, a prestigious centre of non-university-based philosophical research;
- to choose a supervisor also from the ranks of researchers at the Institute of Philosophy of the CAS and thus have the option of selecting your dissertation subject from a wider range of options;
- to participate in projects of both your home department and the Institute of Philosophy of the CAS and use their libraries and research support.

Stipend: basis of 10,500 CZK a month (net) with possibilities of further increase.
