The Scientific Board of the *Bohemian Reformation and Religious Practice* (BRRP) platform is pleased to announce a call for proposals to organise the upcoming biennial symposium, scheduled to take place in June 2026.

The BRRP symposia, founded in 1994 by David R. Holeton and Zdeněk V. David, have a tradition spanning over thirty years. They serve as a scholarly forum for specialists in the field of the Bohemian Reformation and related areas, characterised by an intentionally broad thematic scope. Following a reform in 2024, the format now prioritises thematically focused symposia. We therefore invite scholars from the broad international network engaged in research on the Bohemian Reformation to submit proposals for a symposium topic.

Selected applicant will be responsible for organising the symposium in close collaboration with, and with the support of, the BRRP Scientific Board. Organisers will also have the opportunity to publish a thematically related volume under the BRRP imprint.

The deadline for submitting proposals for the 2026 symposium is 8 June 2025. Proposals must be submitted via the online form available at the following link: https://shorturl.at/wZn4h

Each proposal should include the following information:

- Names and institutional affiliations of the proposed organisers
- Title and thematic focus of the proposed symposium
- Abstract describing the topic of the proposed symposium (between 2400 and 4000 characters, including spaces)
- Preliminary list of possible speakers and/or proposed panels or lecture topics
- Names of suggested keynote speakers
- Proposed duration of the symposium (2 or 3 days, provisionally set for 17–19 June 2026, subject to discussion)
- Indication of interest in publishing a thematic volume based on the symposium
- Information on potential funding sources for the symposium and any related publication

The Scientific Board will review submissions and contact selected organisers by the end of June 2025. Selected organisers, in cooperation with the Board, will proceed with further planning steps, including issuing a Call for Papers by the end of September 2025, which will be disseminated with the Board's assistance. The Board reserves the right not to select any of the submitted proposals.
