### **SELECTION PROCESS**

**I.** A written test in foreign language (languages to choose from: English/German/Italian/Spanish/French/Russian; applicant always chooses a language other than his/her native one); max. 20 points

#### II. Interview

- Discussion of applicant's written presentation of previous publication and educational activities in the field; max. 30 points
- Discussion of applicant's written proposal of dissertation project; max. 50 points

Minimum number of points for admission is 70, of which at least 10 points must be awarded for the language test.

### FORM OF STUDY

Both full-time and combined

Maximum number of applicants accepted: 6 for each form of study

- winter deadline: 10 January 2021- summer deadline: 30 April 2021

- Submission fee must be paid by submission deadline. In case the applicant does not attend admission examinations or cancels the application, the fee is not returned.

# GENERAL AND AREA SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTERING THE ADMISSION PROCEDURE:

- A correct submission of an electronic application including all the required documents;
- Presentation of an officially authenticated copy of a master's diploma from a programme in philosophy or a closely related field;
- Sending of the application by 10 January 2021 (winter deadline) or 5 June 2021 (summer deadline) to the Dean's Office of the Faculty of Theology of the University of South Bohemia. This part of submission must include a written proposal of dissertation thesis and a list of previous publication and education activities in the field.
